### *"The Full Monte"*

Akua printmaking ink and printing plates will be provided by instructor, as well as PanPastels and applicators.

I know this list seems like a lot of stuff, but don't feel you must bring everything. There will be a lot of sharing going on!

- LARGE container baby wipes
- Finger nail scrub brush to clean brayers and hands
- Soft pastels travel set (Blue Earth, Great American, Schmincke, Sennelier half sticks, Terry Ludwig, Diane Townsend Terrages are all good), with wrappers off and organized by color/value)
- Small selection of watersoluble crayons, markers, pencils,
- Small collection mark making tools that don't scratch plastic (ie., wooden pottery tools or plastic combs)
- 1 or more 1—4 inch soft Speedball or similar rubber brayer. You will benefit from having at least 2 brayers of different widths. Note: this is not foam, but a rubber that has "give." These are available at your local hobby store or on line.
- Several thin plastic texture stencils or 8x10 stencil material (ie., Graphix stencil material) to make your own with an exacto knife. This can be any material that is thin, waterproof, and curl-proof material. It does not have to be see through.
- Small set (6-8) oil pastels
- 1 piece Diane Townsend dry pigment ground either white or umber OR 1 stick of Diane Townsend white Terrage pastel.
- PanPastels and applicators NOTE: the instructor will bring many for you to try if you don't have them.
- PAPER: 2 pads of 20 pc Strathmore Printmaking 400 series pad 8x10 size OR 2 pads 11x14 size.
- 1- 1" roll low tack masking tape
- Wax paper or parchment paper (from your grocery store)
- A few flat brushes, 1/2"-1"
- 1 small tube BLACK water mixable oil paint
- One roll paper towels.
- Flat piece of plastic or disposable palette paper 9x12 pad for rolling out inks and paint
- Anything else in the way of acrylic or markers is fine....just limit yourself to 1-3 colors.
- Exacto knife/blades AND set of 5 FLAT razor blades (plastic or metal)
